



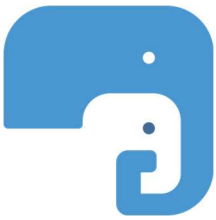
- Smartcare has added the ability to get all custom fields (and values) to the data normally returned from the Child Get API

Bug Fix 1: Smartcare enrollment form crash

- Some customers experienced app crashes when attempting to complete the online enrollment process. This has been resolved.

Bug Fix 2: Smartcare report timeouts
