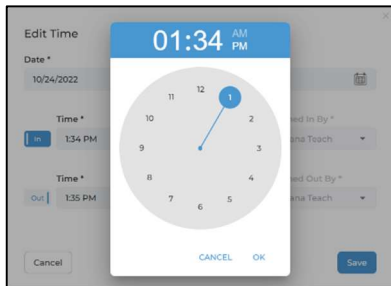

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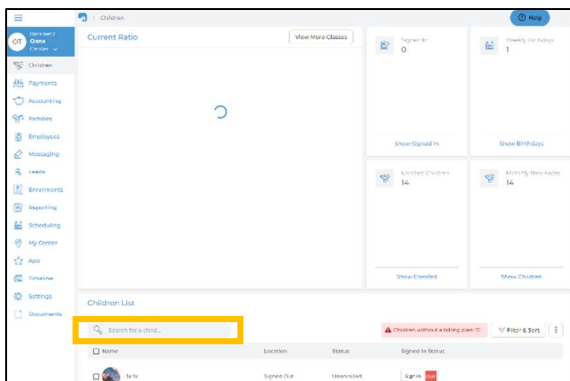
Note: iOS and Android releases may occur several days after publication of release notes due to required Apple and Google reviews of applications in their stores.

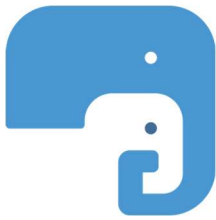
New Feature 1: Standard Time (AM/PM) is now utilized in the Smartcare Teacher Web, Center Web, and Parent Web applications. You will now be able to select AM or PM and manipulate the clock widget to input times in Smartcare.



New Feature 2: The Smartcare Center Web application will allow for both typing and copy and pasting of dates when adding a schedule to a child's profile.

New Feature 3: When entering the Children's Tab in the Smartcare Center Web application, the cursor will first appear in the search box to allow for faster searching of the children in the center.





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New Feature 4: The “Done” button when accepting a payment in the Smartcare Center iOS application has been modified to a “Continue” button to better reflect the appropriate flow of actions and take the user to the appropriate receipt screen.



Bug Fixes:

- Tuition plans are now listed alphabetically in the Smartcare Center Web application.
 - My Center > Billing Settings > Tuition Plans
- “Non-Needy” was missing from the available dropdown options when selecting a child’s food program information in the Smartcare Center Web application
 - Children > USDA Food Program > Food Program drop down
- Users were unable to edit the time of a child’s attendance in the Smartcare Center Web application
 - Children > Attendance > Select existing In or Out time entry and attempt to edit
- An error message will now appear when a user attempts to sign in a child using a time in the future with the Smartcare Center Web application
 - Children > Select Child > Click on Sign In > Select Drop-Off Person > Attempt to select a time in the future
- The Smartcare Center Web application was showing an error when users were attempting to sign out a child
 - Children > Select Child > Attempt to sign out the child
- The Smartcare Center Web application was requiring additional instructions to be added if a child’s first instruction was removed, but there were still instructions available
- In some instances, a picture added for an adult in the Smartcare Center Web application, was showing as the image on the My Center tab.
- In some instances, the Parent Web application was not allowing parents to modify their photos
- The Smartcare Teacher Web application has been corrected to require the type of timeline entry when a teacher is submitting a new entry.
